Travel to Ann Arbor

Airport (DTW)

The Detroit Metropolitan Airport is approximately 30 minutes from Ann Arbor.

Amtrak (ARB)

The Amtrak Station in Ann Arbor is located no more than 10 minutes from the University of Michigan's North Campus and from the Residence Inn Ann Arbor North.

Shuttles from DTW (Detroit Metropolitan Airport)

- **Ann Arbor Metro** – (734) 507-9220 (annarbormetro.com)
Note: tell them where you are staying – they tell us they charge \$50 from the airport and \$40 from Ann Arbor to the airport for 1 – 5 people. *They charge by the trip, not per person as long as it is the same destination, but verify this when you call.* This is an airport shuttle only – not local trips.
- **Ann Arbor Cab** – (734) 272-8009
Note: They tell us the charge is \$60 from the airport and \$60 from Ann Arbor to the airport for 4 – 6 people. *They charge by the trip, not per person as long as it is the same destination but verify this when you call.* They offer cab service for local trips also.
- **A2 Area MetroRide Taxi** – (734) 709-1204
Note: They tell us the charge is \$55 from the airport and \$55 from Ann Arbor to the airport for up to 4 people. *They charge by the trip, not per person as long as it is the same destination but verify this when you call.*
- **Blue Car/Cab** – (734) 846-0007
Note: they tell us the charge is \$75 from the airport and \$65 from Ann Arbor to the airport for up to 4 people. *They charge by the trip, not per person as long as it is the same destination, but verify this when you call.* They offer cab service for local trips also.

Michigan Flyer is a motorcoach and the least expensive (only \$22 roundtrip), but additional transportation will be necessary from and to the pick-up and drop-off location, Blake Transit Center at 328 South Fifth Avenue in Ann Arbor 48104.

While visitor parking is available in Parking Lot, NC-8, across from the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Library, it is limited and costly (\$1.50 per hour). We strongly suggest using the motorcoach which will pick guests up in the front of the Residence Inn Ann Arbor North promptly at 7:30 a.m. (one trip only). The folks at the Library are requesting **no parking in the Library lot**. Spaces are limited and they would like to make sure that there are plenty of spaces for those dropping by to visit the Library and for those servicing Library needs and meetings.

Saturday, October 8 – MSGC Fall Conference

Good news! Parking is free and usually abundant on weekends, therefore, transportation provided by the conference is not planned at this time. (Parking Lots: NC-28, NC-74 and NC-22). The conference venue, François-Xavier Bagnoud Building, is located just five minutes or so from the Residence Inn Ann Arbor North with parking lots located nearby (https://pts.umich.edu/maps/north_medical.pdf).
